**PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 2100-2019**

**DECLARING AUGUST 12 OF EVERY YEAR AS THE ANNUAL  
OBSERVANCE AND CELEBRATION OF THE LINGGO NG KABATAAN IN  
THE PROVINCE OF PALAWAN PURSUANT TO REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10742  
OR “THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN REFORM ACT OF 2015”**

**WHEREAS**, Section 13, Article II of the Constitution provides that *“The State shall recognize the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being and shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;”*

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 10742 or the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015 provides that *“Every barangay, municipality and province shall conduct an annual activity to be known as the Linggo ng Kabataan on the week where the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August falls to coincide with the International Youth Day;”*

**WHEREAS**, the development of the youth sector in the Province of Palawan is one of the priorities of the Provincial Government in terms of the protection of their rights, promotion of their general welfare, as well as youth participation and development;

**WHEREAS**, the celebration for the youth and conducting activities specially devoted to their total development would help address and properly appreciate the role of the youth in society and the substantial returns that would accrue from a determined investment in their development through livelihood training, sport minding activities and personality development;

**WHEREAS**, this is to uphold the rights and ensure the promotion of general welfare of the youth and their protection from acts, conditions or influence that are prejudicial to their development;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Honorable Sharon Abiog-Onda duly seconded;

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN IN SESSION:**

**Section 1. TITLE** – This Ordinance shall be known and cited as Provincial Ordinance No. 2100, series of 2019 entitled: **DECLARING AUGUST 12 OF EVERY YEAR AS THE ANNUAL OBSERVANCE AND CELEBRATION OF THE LINGGO NG KABATAAN IN THE PROVINCE OF PALAWAN PURSUANT TO REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10742 OR “THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN REFORM ACT OF 2015”**

**Section 2. POLICY** - The State shall recognize the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being and shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;

**Section 3. GENERAL OBJECTIVES** - The Barangay Sangguniang Kabataan Council shall conduct different activities to achieve the following purposes:

- 3.1. To inculcate among the youth discipline, respect for the rights of others, sportsmanship and quest for excellence;
- 3.2. To develop camaraderie, promote competition as a vehicle of brotherhood and cooperation among the youth;

- 3.3. To serve as a training ground for the management and implementation of government programs;
- 3.4. To promote Sangguniang Kabataan as an organization vital for the enhancement of moral, cultural, intellectual and physical development of the youth.

#### **Section 4. PROGRAMS and ACTIVITIES**

- 4.1. On the Spot Logo and Slogan Contest for the youth's artistic expression of patriotism, nationalism and social issues (i.e. environmental awareness, child labor/abuse etc.). This activity is primarily directed towards the development and improvement of arts and culture;
- 4.2. There shall be sports festival and fitness activities among the SK Officials and other youth organizations to nurture unity and rekindle camaraderie among these youth leaders;
- 4.3. There shall be Youth Health Day Program, which shall aim to address specific youth health problems and concerns;
- 4.4. There shall be a culminating day to award outstanding young individuals in the academe, government, sports and arts. Other organizations and institutions which are supportive of vital youth issues and concerns shall also be recognized;
- 4.5. Community service activities whereby the youth through their respective SK Chapters conduct pre-planned activities that enable them to come up with their own noble objectives. Activities such as Clean and Green, visiting and sharing with indigents, orphans and disadvantaged groups and free medical mission aim to promote their sense of social commitment, social responsibility and civic mindedness;
- 4.6. Leadership training and other skills development workshops;
- 4.7. Nothing contained herein shall hinder the SK Council from coming up with other programs and activities, it may deem suitable and effective for the celebration of the Linggo ng Kabataan in their respective barangay;

**Section 5. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE** - There shall be an Executive Committee to be composed of the Officers of the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) in their barangay and Project Coordinator which shall oversee the conduct of the Sangguniang Kabataan celebration;

The executive committee shall organize working committee to manage the implementation of the different component programs and such other committees necessary for the success of the activity.

**Section 6. COUNTERPART OF LOCAL AND NATIONAL AGENCIES** - All local elective and appointive officials, as well as heads of national offices and agencies stationed or assigned in the territorial jurisdiction of local government unit are enjoined to provide necessary coordinative and logistical support to ensure the success of the programs;

**Section 7. FUNDS** - The required funds needed for the implementation of the Linggo ng Kabataan shall be duly allocated from the Sangguniang Kabataan funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures in the disbursement of funds.

**Section 8. EFFECTIVITY** – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
