



Notes:

- Contractual personnel are those whose employment in the government is in accordance with a special contract to undertake a specific work or job, requiring special or technical skills not available in the employing agency, to be accomplished within a specific period, which in no case shall exceed one year, and performs or accomplished the specific work or job, under his own responsibility with a minimum of direction and supervision from the hiring agency. (Source: Presidential Decree No. 807 October 6, 1975)
- Contract of Services/Job Orders are employees whose services rendered are not considered governments services and do not enjoy the benefits enjoyed by government employees. The job order covers piece work or intermittent job of short duration not exceeding six months on a daily basis. (Source: Omnibus Rules Implementing Book V of E.O. 292 and Other Pertinent Civil Service Laws)
- The account Contractual/Job Order/Contract of Service is combined under the new chart of accounts in compliance to PPSAS (Philippine Public Sector Accounting Standards).
