Description

INVITATION FOR THE NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT (TWO FAILED BIDDINGS) FOR THE RENOVATION OF PALAWAN PROVINCIAL CRIME LABORATORY OFFICE

1. The Provincial Government of Palawan, through its Locally Funded (OBR No. 300-23-07-10612) account intends to apply the sum of Two Million Sixteen Thousand Pesos Only (Php 2,016,000.00) as Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for the RENOVATION OF PALAWAN PROVINCIAL CRIME LABORATORY OFFICE located at BGY. TINIGUIBAN, PUERTO PRINCESA CITY, PALAWAN, PALAWAN (Project Reference No. B2 GF SB2 PEO 23-07-098). Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

2. In view of the Two (2) Failed Biddings conducted on the said project, the Provincial Government of Palawan now invites interested bidder to participate in the Negotiated Procurement of the RENOVATION OF PALAWAN PROVINCIAL CRIME LABORATORY OFFICE located at BGY. TINIGUIBAN, PUERTO PRINCESA CITY, PALAWAN, PALAWAN in accordance with Section 53.1 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 9184 otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act". Completion of the Works is required within ninety (90) calendar days. Bidder should have completed, within ten (10) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least seventy five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

4. Prospective bidder should possess a valid PCAB License applicable to the contract, have completed a similar contract with a value of at least 50% of the ABC, and have key personnel and equipment (listed in eligibility forms) available for the prosecution of the contract. The BAC will use non - discretionary pass/fail criteria in the Eligibility Check/Screening as well as the Preliminary Examination of the Bid. The BAC will conduct post -qualification of the lowest calculated bidder.

5. A Certificate of Site Inspection which shall be issued by the Provincial Engineering Office shall be required and must be submitted as part of the Technical Component of the bid in order for the prospective bidder to determine the general characteristics and condition of the project such as the location and the nature of the work, geological conditions at the site, communication facilities and availability of construction aggregates and other materials, labor, water, electric power and access roads; and other factors that may affect the cost, duration and execution or implementation of the contract.

6. Interested bidders may obtain further information from Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Secretariat, Provincial Government of Palawan and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours. Monday to Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

7. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on October 18, 2023 from the address below.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Provincial Government of Palawan.

8. Bids must be delivered and received On or before 1:30 PM of October 25, 2023 at the Office of the BAC Secretariat, East Wing, 2nd floor, Gov. Ramon V. Mitra Building, Capitol Compound, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 18.

Bid opening shall be at 2:00 PM of October 25, 2023 at BAC Conference Room, East Wing, 2nd floor, Gov. Ramon V. Mitra Building, Capitol Compound, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders or the duly authorized representatives. Late bids shall not be accepted.
