**CREATING AND INSTITUTIONALIZING PROVINCIAL BOXING
COUNCIL TO ADVANCE AND IMPROVE THE BOXING SKILLS OF
THE YOUNG ASPIRING PALAWEÑO BOXERS IN THE PROVINCE OF
PALAWAN AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF**

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 17 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution expressly provides that “The State shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture, and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress, and promote total human liberation and development;

WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 19 (a) of the said Law provides that: “It is the duty of the State to promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, inducing training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry;”

WHEREAS, boxing has become one of the most popular sports in the Country as the best Filipino boxers compete in international matches;

WHEREAS, due to the popularity of boxing, it attracted many youths here in the Province, and there are many aspiring Palaweño boxers who are thriving and performing greatly in local and national competitions;

WHEREAS, there is a scarcity of support and training for the aspiring boxers preventing them to unleash their full potential as great boxers;

WHEREAS, thus, to promote sports excellence to our aspiring Palaweño boxers and help them achieve their full potential, this measure aims to institutionalize boxing training and program through the Provincial Sports Division Office;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Roseller S. Pineda duly seconded,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN IN SESSION:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the “**Palawan Boxing Ordinance of 2023.**”

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY - It is hereby declared the policy of the State to promote sports excellence and develop Filipino athletes into international-caliber competitors. It is also the State’s policy to enhance the skills of every aspiring boxer in the Country through the scientific method of training to sustain the standing of Filipino boxers as World Champions.


SECTION 3. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES - Essentially the main purpose of institutionalizing Boxing sport in the province of Palawan is to provide support and empower our aspiring and active Palaweño boxers.

SECTION 4. SCOPE OF APPLICATION - This Ordinance shall apply to all boxing-related activities of the Provincial Government of Palawan.

SECTION 5. CREATION AND FUNCTIONS - There is hereby created a **Provincial Boxing Council (PBC)** which shall assist the Provincial Sports Division Office in planning, information dissemination, and implementation of this Ordinance and shall be composed of the following :

Chairperson : Governor or his duly authorized representative

Vice-Chairperson : Vice Governor or his duly authorized representative



- Members : Chairperson, Committee on Youth & Sports of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan
- : Chairperson, Committee on Games and Amusement of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan
- : Provincial Sports Division Office

The Provincial Boxing Council shall have the following functions and responsibilities to wit:

1. The Council shall meet once every quarter to formulate and facilitate plans/ programs;
2. Provide aspiring boxers training to enhance and hone their boxing skills;
3. To provide physical training facility and equipment to use during training;
4. Oversee and ensure the implementation of the programs and activities in the Province;
5. Disseminate information regarding the programs to encourage active participation of interested aspiring boxers;
6. Assists in the identification, recruitment, and training of aspiring boxers from their localities;
7. Submit a quarterly report to the Provincial Sports Division Office; and
8. Perform other functions deemed necessary to promote and implement said Ordinance.

SECTION 6. IMPLEMENTING AGENCY - It shall be the duty of the Office of the Provincial Sports Office to implement this Ordinance efficiently and effectively.

SECTION 7. FUNDING REQUIREMENT - The necessary appropriation to carry out the implementation of this Ordinance shall be allocated in the Annual Budget under the Office of the Provincial Sports Division Office.

SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any part or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect;

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE - All other Ordinances and Executive Orders or part thereof inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after posting in three (3) conspicuous places and publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Palawan.
